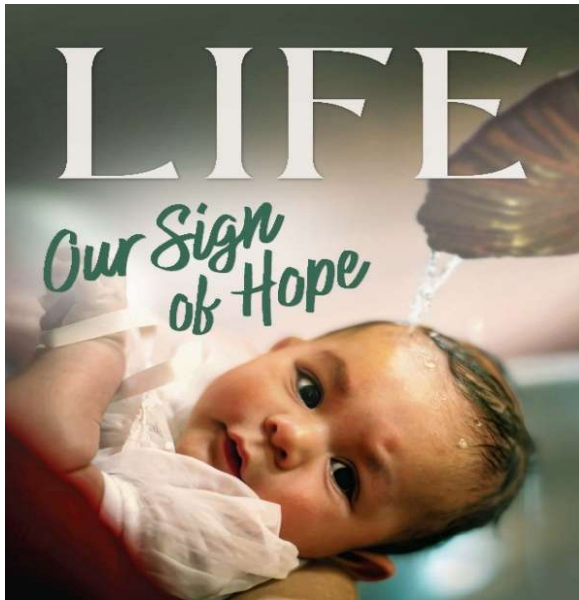
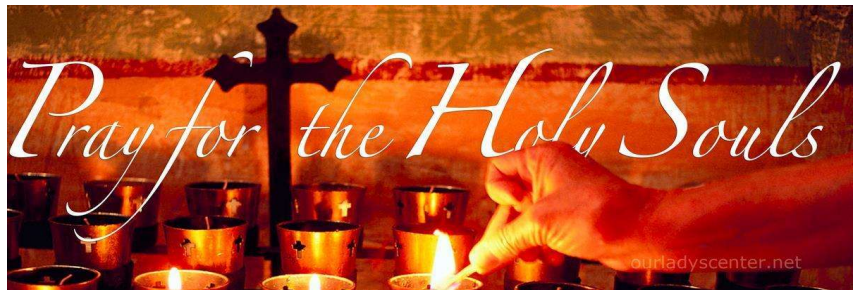


### Blessing of Hunters

## All Souls Day Indulgence – November 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>

We can gain a plenary indulgence for a deceased loved one from November 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> by visiting a cemetery and praying for that person. The other requirements to obtain the indulgence are attendance at Mass and reception of Holy Communion, a sacramental Confession, prayers for the Pope's intentions (a Creed, Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be) and to be detached from all sin. A plenary indulgence is an immediate release from Purgatory for the deceased person.

# PSR NEWS

We had another very successful Wednesday evening in the PSR program on October 22nd! All of the classes began their Theology of the Body (TOB) lessons, and our saint of the week was Pope St. John Paul II. It was most perfect that JP 2's Memorial day in the Church was October 22nd. His original work, a series of 129 addresses delivered by him during his Wednesday Audiences over a period of several years from September 5, 1979 – November 28, 1984, became what is now referred to as the "Theology of the Body". TOB addresses: why God created us, humans are created in God's image; our bodies and souls are a composite union; our actions with our bodies matter; God is a perfect communion of love; and Christ's redemption restores our relationship with God, addressing the effects of sin. We will have a TOB lesson approximately once per month.

Next week we will get back into our regular lessons. At the end of the evening at our next session, we will have a brief celebration of students with a September and October birthdays. Please join us on our Facebook group, St. Francis de Sales PSR. There you will find our weekly newsletter, see our announcements and read about the "Saint of the Day". Anyone is welcome join the Facebook group, even if they do not have a child in the PSR program. 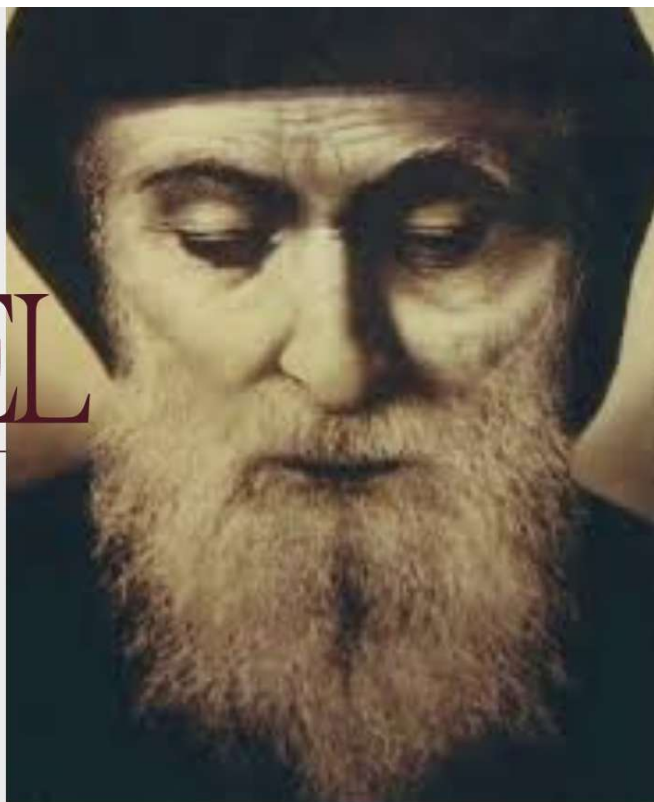

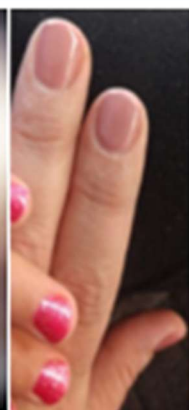


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
