





Prayer Campaign

As we pass the midway point of Lent and look towards new life poking through bare ground outside and shining forth in Baptism and Eucharist inside our churches, another battle is upon us here in Missouri. This fall, we will be asked to vote about abortion. Sadly, 30% of Catholic Missourians do not know that Amendment 3 will be on the ballot.

We are encouraging every Catholic to begin praying for the passage of Amendment 3 **NOW**.

Here in our diocese, please join Bishop Edward M. Rice in praying for the sanctity of life in the sacrifice of the Holy Mass at Holy Trinity Parish, Springfield on March 25th at 8:30am.

In Nov. 2024, Missouri narrowly passed a sweeping right to abortion in the State Constitution. With this State Constitutional Amendment, Missouri's legislature lost the ability to set meaningful safeguards for the abortion industry, including:

- Requirement that only doctors perform abortions
- Requirement that parents be notified and give consent before their minor has an abortion
- Requirement that abortion clinics be licensed and inspected

In addition, because the amendment provided a broad and nearly absolute right to "reproductive health care," it likely opens the door to constitutional protection for surgical or medical gender transition on minors.

In Nov. 2026, Missourians will be asked to restore these protections in Amendment 3, which will:

- Severely limit the number of abortions in the state
- Require abortion clinics to meet high standards for safety and cleanliness
- Ensure parental or judicial consent for minors
- Prohibit gender-altering procedures for minors
- Severely limit public funding for abortion services

Archbishop Rozanski Testifies on Bill to End Death Penalty

A Missouri House bill to abolish the death penalty finally received a committee hearing, and Archbishop Mitchell T. Rozanski attended on behalf of the Missouri bishops to offer testimony in support. [House Bill 2153](#), sponsored by [Rep. Jim Murphy](#), a Republican representing a portion of south St. Louis County, would eliminate the death penalty as a sentencing option in the state. The hearing for the bill took place on March 9 in the Missouri House's Corrections and Public Institutions Committee. This was the first time in ten years that a death penalty repeal bill has been heard in committee, despite legislation being filed virtually every year.
