Learn chain stitches to make a bracelet.

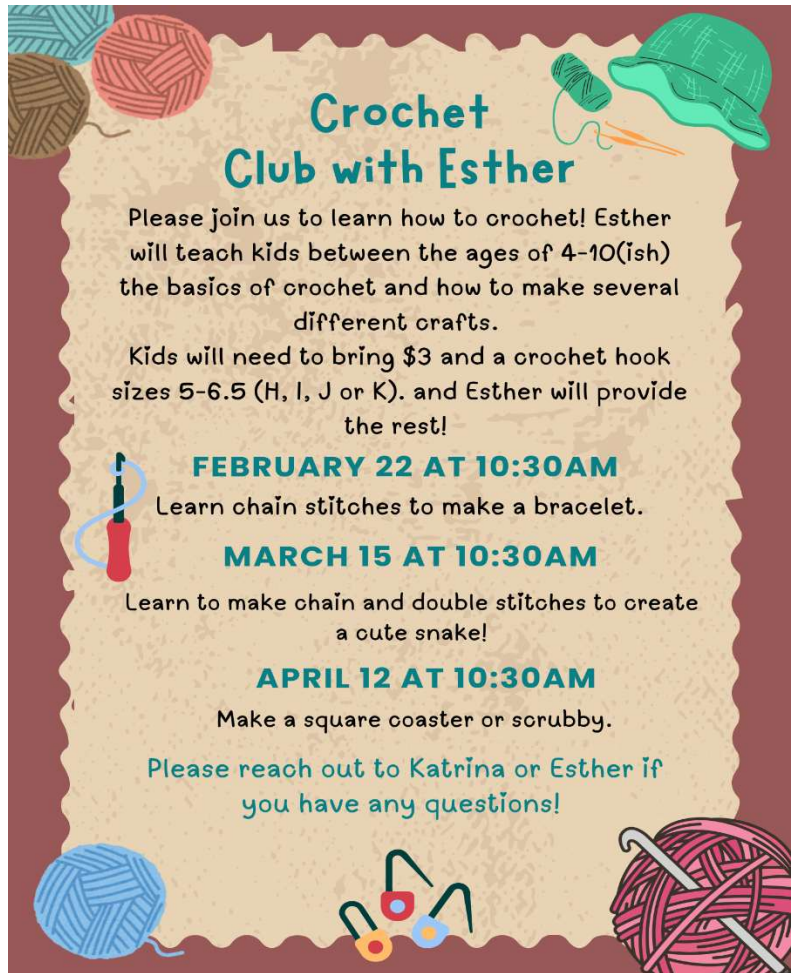

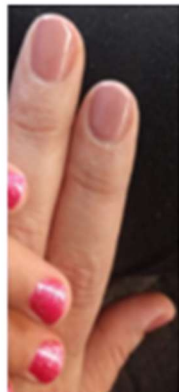

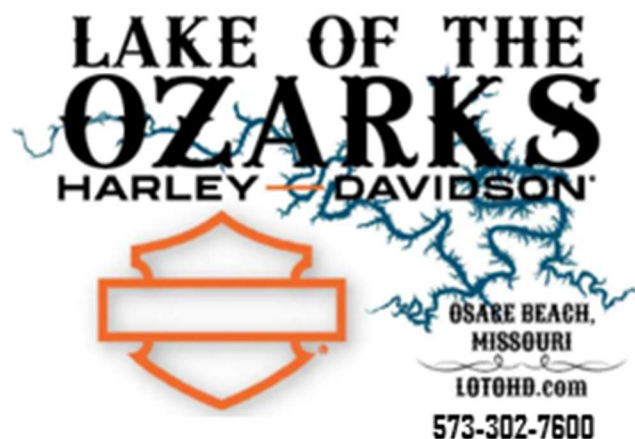
